Thank you for choosing Westside Animal Clinic for your healthcare needs. The following paperwork is for those of you in need of obtaining Health Certificates for the sale of your puppies or kittens. In order to properly complete your certificates, we require pertinent information from you. Having this information prior to your appointment allows us to prepare the paperwork during your appointment to lessen the wait time.

What to expect at your visit: Our doctors give each baby a thorough examination, and required vaccinations recommended for the age of the litter. We take a stool sample from all babies to check for intestinal parasites and give a general deworming medication as recommended by the CDC and required for a Florida state Health Certificate. If everyone in the litter is healthy and the sample is negative, the doctor then signs the health certificate and your babies are now ready to go to their forever homes. And of course our staff will give them plenty of kisses and hugs!

It is advised to bring us in a recent stool sample from multiple babies one week prior to your scheduled appointment. By doing a pre-emptive stool check (**at no charge by the way**), we will be able to check for any intestinal parasites and if necessary treat prior to your appointment to avoid a delay in obtaining your certificate.

This does not allow us to forego the parasite test at the time of appointment. We are legally required to obtain stool samples at the time your puppies/kittens are examined for the Health Certificates. By doing this ahead of time it helps avoid making additional trips to our office and therefore avoids accruing additional fees.
